### **12. Protect Children from Secondhand Smoke**

Helping parents to quit smoking and eliminating children's exposure to secondhand smoke is a national priority. "[Clinical Effort Against Secondhand Smoke Exposure \(CEASE\): Development of Framework and Intervention,](#)" which appears in the August issue of *Pediatrics*, outlines the conceptually grounded and focus group-tested CEASE intervention that is now available for implementation in the pediatric outpatient setting. Those interested in learning how to protect their patients from secondhand smoke may be interested in participating in the new CEASE PROS study, which will teach practices to help parents quit smoking and establish and enforce no-smoking rules in the home and car.
