

Biology in Balance

In the continuing **Exciting Biologies** series, Cell Press, Massachusetts General Hospital, and Fondation IPSEN collaborate to offer annual meetings focused on an area of emerging intersection between disciplines, where fruitful interactions help identify new frontiers in addressing key issues in biomedicine. With the 2009 meeting focusing on **'Biology in Balance'** we draw together scientists studying various aspects of homeostasis and balance from a diverse range of approaches and disciplines. We will start by introducing the concept of balance and system robustness, and then examine how balance and homeostasis are established and maintained within a cell, tissue, organism, or population. Topics will include the mechanisms that maintain balance, how systems adjust balance, how balance can be tipped, and what happens when balance is lost. Our goal is to create an atmosphere where extended group discussion can stimulate interaction between scientists approaching similar problems from different perspectives in order to identify common themes and inspire future directions. Space will be limited, so early registration is encouraged.
